A fill-in template for measuring preparation before the Trigger Year.

Before the trigger, the scorecard measures preparation rather than delivery. Its metrics are within any community's reach. Each maps to a delivery metric in Table 14.1 of the blueprint — the baseline is being built before T+0 arrives. The Imagining Cameroon Trust publishes the returns annually as the State of Readiness report, region by region, division by division.

Evidence means something a third party can check: a registration certificate, an audited account, a training certificate, a signed boundary record, a partnership agreement, a bank or escrow statement. Funds under the pre-trigger vehicles move on verification, not on letters. Submit completed

scorecards to the Imagining Cameroon Trust via imaginingcameroon.org for inclusion in the annual State of Readiness report.
